- ii project description (max. 3 pages, font: Arial; font size: 11 pt; line spacing: 1.5)
- iii a one-page summary of the project
- iv budget form
- v CV and list of previous publications of the applicants (if any)
- vi letter of commitment regarding financial, personal and material support by the head of the hematology training center where the research will be performed
- vii completed form "basic data"

All requested documents must be in English language.
